



Enrollment Process:

Virginia A&M Prep Academy services athletes-students who haven't been recruited or are uncommitted to college at level.

To Be Eligible for Enrollment at Virginia A&M Prep Academy

- **Academic Qualifier:** The recruit is **immediately eligible** to receive an athletics scholarship and participate in practice and competition during the **first year** of full-time college enrollment.
- **Partial Non-Qualifier:** The recruit was a late qualifier in meeting the NCAA eligibility standards. The recruit may not practice but not compete with your team or receive an athletics scholarship during your first year of college enrollment. Note: The recruit is eligible at the DII level.
- **Non-Qualifiers:** The recruit has failed to meet NCAA Academic Requirements, set by NCAA I or II standards
- **Reclassifying:** High School Seniors who would like to reclassify.

Enrollment Process:

1. Complete a Virginia A&M Prep Academy Online Application (Note: You must submit the \$50.00 application fee once you have completed uploading **ALL** the required documents or your application will be deleted).
2. Upload all High School your Current High School Transcripts including Test Scores, Parents **MUST** submit a Copy of Parent Tax transcripts, and IEP and 504 plan if available.
3. Upload your counselor and Head Football Coach recommendation forms within (48) hours.
4. Student and Parent(s) schedule and attend a Virginia A&M Prep Academy Interview/Consultation.
5. SAT (Standardized Athletic Test. Sponsored by Zybek Official Partner of the N.F.L. Athletic test.

Out-of-state Recruits:

We greatly welcome out-of-state recruits. However, please note that Virginia A&M Prep Academy does not own or operate a housing facility; however, we provide safe housing recommendations. We also only offer a limited meal plan for all our recruits: Local, In-State, and Out-of-State. **(Note: All visits are by appointment and are at your own expense.)**

Note: The Virginia A&M Prep Academy (9) month program has a year-round open-door—recruitment and enrollment policy.
