

2022 Ephrata Youth Football Parade Float

It's that time of year again! We will again be participating in the Ephrata Parade on **Wednesday, September 21**. We will be accepting candy donations for the players to hand out along the parade route. A plastic tote will be available in the shed for you to drop candy off during practices. We would love to have as much candy as possible dropped off at the shed by September 15 so that we can bag it up for the kids ahead of time. We will still accept it up to parade night.

On the bottom of this sheet is a permission slip for players to be able to walk and ride on the float in the parade. Permission slips must be turned in by Tuesday, September 20, no exceptions. There is a box in the shed where you can drop your permission slip by September 20. You can also turn them in to your team mom. Players will not be allowed to walk in the parade without a signed permission slip. Please remind your player that they are representing Ephrata Youth Football in the parade – we expect the spectators to be impressed by their fabulous behavior! Also, please make sure they know they should hand out the candy, NOT throw the candy to the spectators.

We are #22 in the parade and will probably be starting in front of the high school. Players and chaperones should meet at the lower library parking lot, next to the skate park at 6:00 pm. At 6:15 we will walk to the float together. Teams will take turns riding on the float and walking and handing out candy. All players should wear their game jersey and regular shorts or pants and sneakers. Players must stay with the group for the entire parade route. Players can be picked up at the corner of Oak Blvd. & W. Queen St. Please check in with your player's coach when you pick them up so we can be sure everyone goes home with the right person!

Also, we would be glad to have parents come along to help chaperone and do crowd control! (Please wear purple or gold or an Ephrata shirt if possible!)
