Player Code of Conduct

-I will be responsible for and care for the equipment issued to me and the equipment used at practice.

-I will avoid unnecessary "fooling around" and unsafe behavior at practices and sidelines during games.

-I will show respect for my coaches, teammates, cheerleaders, officials, opponents, MVYFL volunteers, and myself at all times.

*I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, fellow teammate, opponent, volunteer, spectator, or parent; such as booing, taunting, and refusing to shake hands.

*I will not use profanity, abusive language, physical fighting or obscene gestures. This will not be tolerated.

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY:

- I will refrain from posting or commenting any content that is unsportsmanlike, derogatory, demeaning, or threatening toward a teammate, coach, opponent, or program within MVYFL.

-I will not post or comment anything that negatively impacts or describes the Linganore Lancers youth football program or its players.

I agree and understand that if I fail to abide by the above rules and guidelines, or engage in any other conduct that my coach or the management team deems detrimental to my team or the organization, I will be subject to disciplinary action, which could include, but is not limited to the following:

1. Verbal warning by the coach, team moms, official, or management team.
2. Player game or games suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by the management team.
3. Player season suspension (full or part) as determined by the management team.
4. Expulsion from the organization as determined by the LYF Management team, MVYFL or LOUYAA Board of Directors.
