2023 Falcons Financials

- Other payments that will be due by October 14 (last season game).
 Payments will be available once season starts online for the following:
 - Coaches Gifts
 - Banquet
- Raffle basket donations each team will be asked to put together baskets for Family Day and Pink Out. A parent will need to coordinate for each and gather cash or items from families.

Did you know?

- The Livonia Junior Athletic League is a 501c3 nonprofit organization
- You can make monetary donations and designate the Falcons as the recipient, and use as a tax write off, just ask for our info
- Items that we routinely need to purchase, and update are shoulder pads, helmets, football pants, knee pads, poms and cheer uniforms.
 - To help minimize financial impact, we try to replace shoulder pads and helmets in small batches each season
 - For uniform replacement, we like to replace the whole fleet every 3 to 5 years.

Spirit Wear



- We will have 3 spirit wear stores again for the 2023 season. All stores will be online and open for 1 to 2 weeks. Information will be sent out as soon as we have finalized the details.
- Car decals can be purchased throughout the season at any time for \$5.00 each
- Yard signs will also be available to purchase through July 28th

VOLUNTEERS

- This league is run by volunteers
- Each family is expected to volunteer a minimum of 4 times per season
- Sign up for your slots on our sign up genius- link to come!
- There will be opportunities on game day, special events, behind the scenes and more
- All volunteer slots are equally important, they are what makes the season successful
- Failure to meet volunteer commitments, could result in loss of veteran status
- Item donation sign up (coming soon!) if you sign up to donate any items, this will count as ONE of your volunteer requirements total, regardless of the number of items you donate.
- If you are struggling to meet volunteer commitments please reach out to the directors as soon as possible for an alternate option.

Game Day Volunteers

- Booth Spotter Sit in the announcer booth and relay information to announcer about each play
- Time Clock Operator Operate the time clock and enter score throughout the game
- Chains/Down Marker Down on the "visitor" side of the field marking the downs with the chains and down
 marker
- Concession Worker Take orders from customers, collect payment, prepare/handle food. NO one under 18 can handle money
- Concession Lead make sure items are continually stocked in concession building (including bathrooms) throughout the game, fill in where needed
- Set Up set up Bentley field for game day including raising American flag, field markers, sideline benches, garbage cans, bathroom stock, etc.
- Take Down clean up Bentley field for game day including taking down American flag, field markers, sideline benches, removing trash, cleaning bathrooms, etc.
- Mid Day Clean Up empty trash, pick up under the bleachers, tidy bathrooms and restock
- Grill Grill hotdogs and hamburgers for concessions.
