The new Seven Oaks high school football team, consisting of players from Garden City, Maples and West Kildonan Collegiates, has been accepted into the Winnipeg High School Football League on a one-year trial basis.

The decision was made June 1 at a meeting of the league's athletic council.

Whether the team lasts more than a year will depend on how the schedule works out and on finances.

The schedule seems to be the major issue, however.

Kas Vidruk, director of interscholastic activities for the Winnipeg School Division, says everyone seemed to be happy with the schedule format which was adopted last year.

The 10 teams played doubleheaders on home grounds every Thursday and tripleheaders at the Velodrome on Fridays. That way, every team played one game a week without any having to fit in two games in one week somewhere along the schedule.

However, with the addition of Seven Oaks, they will likely have to go back to playing games on other weekdays as well. At some point in the schedule everyone will have play two games in one week on one or two occasions.
