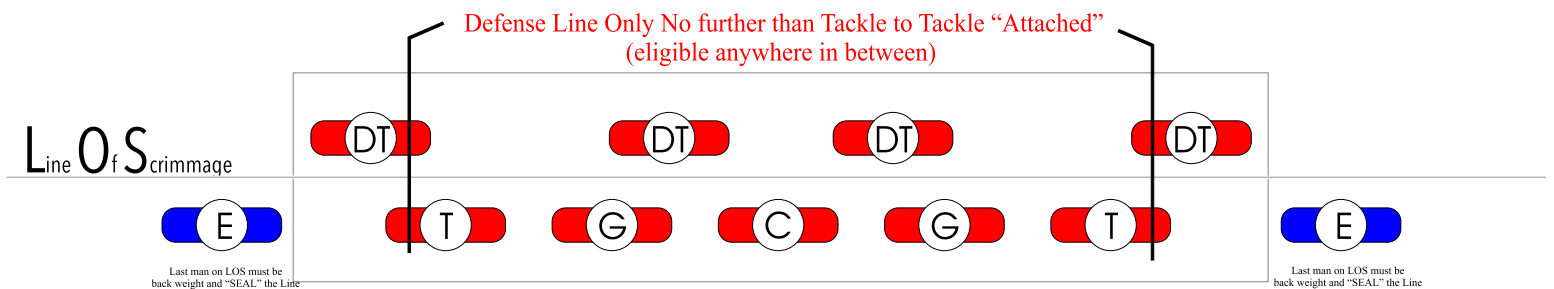




NBJFL "LINE ONLY" PLAYER POSITIONS

DEFENSE

"LINE ONLY" players
Must be in a 3 or 4 point stance
and can not line up any further than the outside shoulder
of the offensive tackle. (they must be at minimum "attached" as depicted below)



OFFENSE

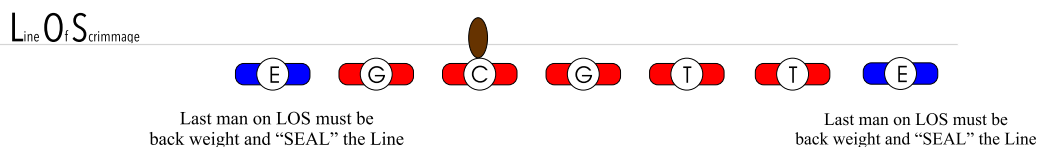
7 players MUST be on the line of scrimmage.

The LAST MAN on the offensive line is an "ELIGIBLE RECEIVER"
Therefore. NO LINE ONLY player may be the last man on the line.

All "LINE ONLY" must be "sealed" by a back weight player.

UNBALANCED LINE

Senerio: with an unbalanced line, the weak side offensive
line player must be of back weight. He is an "Eligible Receiver"



- "Line Only" players are Denoted on the published league rosters as "LO"
- All "LO" players must have 6" of color contrasting tape on both the front and back of the helmet for identification.
- Any "LO" player not properly taped is to be removed from play until corrected.
- No "LO" player may advance the ball
