Covid-19 FAQs

WHAT SHOULD WE DO IF A PLAYER OR A COACH TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?

- Identify when the individual tested positive for COVID-19.
- Identify individuals who were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more. This should include practices, conditioning, camps and/or games.
- Identify those who had direct physical contact, shared eating/drinking utensils or came incontact with respiratory droplets.
- Those within close contact should stay home for 14 days after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19 and watch for fever (100.4∘F), cough, shortness of breath, or other symptoms of COVID-19.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A PLAYER IS EXPOSED AT SCHOOL?

Each ISD's follow the same recommended guidelines from the CDC and UIL. If your player has been placed on quarantine with the school, the player will need to sit out from practices, coditioning, camps and/or games until their quarantine period has ended and they are able to return to school.

WHEN TO START AND END QUARANTINE?

See scenarios provided by the CDC to help determine when you can end quarantine and be around others.

Scenario 1: Close contact with someone who has COVID-19—will not have further close contact

I had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 and will not have further contact or interactions with the person while they are sick (e.g., co-worker, neighbor, or friend).

Your last day of quarantine is 14 days from the date you had close contact.

Date of last close contact with person who has COVID-19 + 14 days= end of quarantine

Scenario 2: Close contact with someone who has COVID-19—live with the person but can avoid further close contact

I live with someone who has COVID-19 (e.g., roommate, partner, family member), and that person has isolated by staying in a separate bedroom. I have had no close contact with the person since they isolated.

Your last day of quarantine is 14 days from when the person with COVID-19 began home isolation.

Scenario 3. Under quarantine and had additional close contact with someone who has COVID-19

I live with someone who has COVID-19 and started my 14-day quarantine period because we had close contact. What if I ended up having close contact with the person who is sick during my quarantine? What if another household member gets sick with COVID-19? Do I need to restart my quarantine?

Yes. You will have to restart your quarantine from the last day you had close contact with anyone in your house who has COVID-19. Any time a new household member gets sick with COVID-19 and you had close contact, you will need to restart your quarantine.

Scenario 4: Live with someone who has COVID-19 and cannot avoid continued close contact

I live in a household where I cannot avoid close contact with the person who has COVID-19. I am providing direct care to the person who is sick, don't have a separate bedroom to isolate the person who is sick, or live in close quarters where I am unable to keep a physical distance of 6 feet.

You should avoid contact with others outside the home while the person is sick, and quarantine for 14 days after the person who has COVID-19 meets the <u>criteria to end home isolation</u>.

Date the person with COVID-19 ends home isolation + 14 days = end of quarantine
