

TEACHER-SUPPORTED

When enrolled in one of our Credit Recovery Courses, or Diploma Program you'll get a message from your teacher. Your teacher is not a bot or some artificial intelligence machine—it's a real-life person, a credentialed professional, who, like you, are working on a computer. You can ask a question at any time, by submitting a form. Your teacher receives an email with your question and responds quickly, usually within 24 hours.

When you submit your assignment, it is graded by your teacher. Teachers will give you some positive feedback and guidance along with a grade for your work and any other relevant comments they have to share.

With this arrangement, it's not necessary to be connected at the same time as the teacher, and that's how we can make our Credit Recovery High School online courses entirely self-paced. Having said that, for some language subjects, like Spanish, you occasionally have to speak to a teacher through video-conference. For these assignments, you'll need to coordinate your schedule with the teacher to make sure you're both able to meet up through video-conference at a time that works for both of you.

Our teachers are well aware of the differences in scheduling and other priorities when students are taking credit recovery high school online courses. That's why they're flexible in multiple areas such as scheduling, deadlines and others, with students that are taking credit recovery high school online courses.

VIDEO-BASED

Many students prefer watching videos to reading textbooks and we use video wherever we can in our Credit Recovery High School online courses.

We try to build out our credit recovery classes using engaging content that is both informative and entertaining to watch. If you're taking a course like English, you're going to have to read a book, but each unit of each course usually includes a video, a quiz, some reading material, and an assignment.
