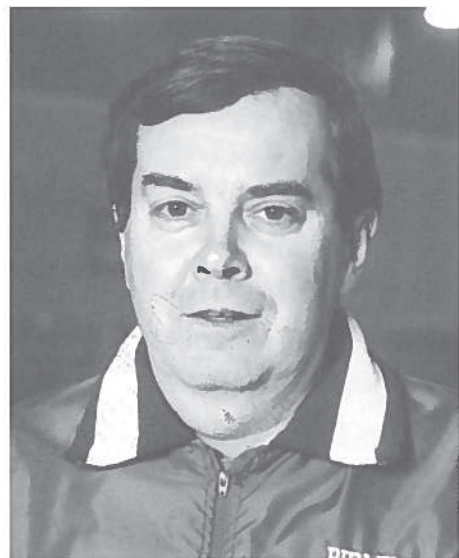

## Welcome To the 1994-95 Birmingham Hockey Season

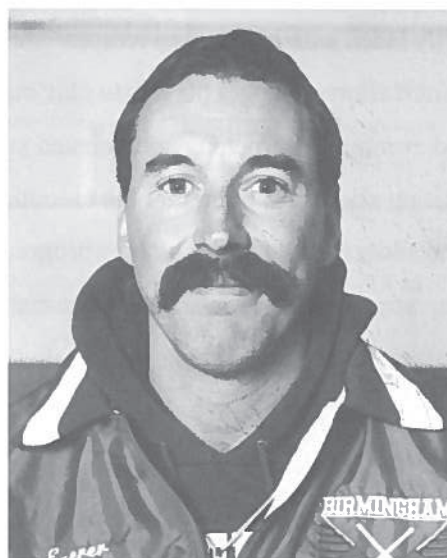
