 - Socks required to buy MMH and talk with Olympic to stock them, evaluation night Olympic will have a form to buy socks
 - Online store through Olympic? Timeout will do it, payment and pre orders done and dealt with vs MMH dealing with payment and chasing money for another thing, or we go back to white/red standard socks
 - Roles/Jobs for that night, need help in the booth for payments, new registrations, Storefront (Bailey, Holly)
 Brent (in the back new shoes w/a stache), Kelby/Derek info booth, Tyler (Traffic control) Ryan will help,

- U7 39 registered (12 Female) 4 teams NEED 45 minimum for 5 teams (4 4yr olds) need to remind 4yr olds NEED
 ONE parent to be on the ice, 4 station practices worked well but look at hybrid, 12/team is manageable,
- U9 44 registered (35 Male and 9 Female) 4 Teams of 11 currently, if we get to 50 then 5 teams ¾ ice, development zone available but not overly used, house league? Hybrid with a few extra home games sponsored from MMH for those who want more? Some
- U11 46 registered coed 3 Female (38 Male and 5 Female) 4 teams, move to 5 when 57, 8 part time goalies, 2 full time, Winkler has an abundance of U11 Goalies
- U13 61 registered coed 2 Female (47 Male and 12 Female) 24 trying out for AA, 56 makes 4, 57+ 5 teams, 6 goalies, 2 player goalies
- U15 29 Male and 6 Female registered before regional 1 team, 22 trying AA,don't think we can host a female team
- U18 23 Male and 5 Female registered, all trying out AA, bank on 1 team
- Miami has reached out as they will not have enough players to register teams at the following levels. The families have made a request to join MMH this season.
 - O U9 5 players
 - U11 7 players
 - O U13 5 players
 - Miami is interested in running a U11 Female team this year, Morden U11 doesn't look like enough to run a stand alone female team

Pre Season Programs

- 3 on 3 116 registered U9-U15 last year 131, 133 in 2022 Sept 3-16th 5pm weekday, 9am weekend
- new layout, and move to adapt to AA tryouts don't overlap
- U13AA Tryouts won't play 3v3 one weekend
- September 14/15, 21/22 Pilot Mound 140 kids registered forming 2 teams
- Conditioning Camp no charge, 2 skates, similar to what is going to be seen at eval between Sep 17-26th ish
- Evaluations Sept 26th to 29th Present options and vote on procedure
 - Option 1 Costs: Minimal VOTED OUT
 - Continue as MMH has done in previous years using local volunteer evaluators & a sub
 - group of executive members to run operations.
 - Option 2 Costs: Minimal CONTENDER
 - Continue as MMH has done in previous years using local volunteer evaluators & arrange a
 - neutral non-executive member to organize evaluators, run operations and collect/enter
 - data. Neutral would mean the person doing so would not have any family members taking
 - part in U11 & U13 evaluations.
 - Note* Steve Mullin has been contacted as a potential candidate for this and has stated he is interested in helping. He also stated that he would not take an honorarium.
 - Option 3 Costs: Minimal VOTED OUT
 - Continue as MMH has done in previous years, but using non-local evaluators & a sub group
 - of executive members to run operations.
 - Note* Brent Davidson & Jocelyn Lamoureux-Davidson are an example of 2 potential non-





- local candidates that have been contacted and expressed interest in helping evaluate.
- Option 4 Costs: \$4,000+ CONTENDER
 - MMH to hire the PV Elite crew to run operations in its entirety
- Option 5 Costs: \$12,044.45 VOTED OUT
 - MMH to hire The Rink crew to run operations in its entirety
- 3 VOTES Option 2
- 7 VOTES Option 4
- 1 VOTE Abstain
- Option 4 CARRIED (\$4000) will charge out on the families to cover the cost
- MMH to contribute \$500 in lieu of Food/Beverages for evaluators so roughly \$3500/100 kids will be \$35/kid
