

Mustang Hockey Association 2014-2015 Registration Fee Breakdown

Mustang Hockey Association is committed to providing a quality hockey program to players of all ages and abilities at a reasonable cost. MHA is run primarily by volunteers. We have one part-time paid position to help with the day-to-day administrative tasks of running a non-profit organization. Association Fees

A portion of every MHA player's registration fee—whether a Competitive or House player—goes towards costs incurred in running the Association:

These costs are approximately \$210 per player.

House Player Fees

The bulk of registration fees paid by House players covers the cost of ice. Please keep in mind that ice costs at the MAC this season rose from \$230 to \$290 per hour.

Ice costs incorporated into fees are as follows:

Atoms/Mini Mites: \$215 Per Player

Mites: \$449 Per Player

Squirts through Midgets (Including Lady Mustangs): \$628 Per Player

The remaining \$149 for Squirts through Midgets covers end of season state tournament participation, referees and pucks.

The remaining \$98 for Atoms, Mini Mites and Mites covers end of season jamboree participation, referees, pucks and equipment.

Comp Player Fees

The remaining \$137 for Competitive players covers team registration with ASHA for the season and participation in the end of season state tournament.
