The University of Toledo Ice Hockey Club is very pleased to announce and invite you to its sixth annual College Prospects Camp. It is our hope that through hosting this camp we can better educate and prepare potential collegiate hockey players as well as get the opportunity to meet and watch many players already interested in playing for the University of Toledo.

Through the series of events we have planned and other opportunities available to participants, we hope to answer many of the questions incoming players and parents have about college hockey. Whether that be with us here at UT or elsewhere, we want players to get the answers they need before deciding where to continue their educational and hockey careers.

This camp is open to all players who are currently juniors in high school or older. This includes all incoming students, current UT students, and players not yet committed or accepted to the university. We understand that there is no stereotypical college hockey player and encourage anyone considering playing college hockey to attend.

Cost of the camp is \$100 and includes:

- 6 hours of ice time over the course of the weekend
- a Toledo Hockey practice jersey each player will be given on the first day
- a Toledo Hockey t-shirt
- a guided tour of the University of Toledo
- a pizza lunch for both the player and his immediate family on Saturday the 26th

### **Itinerary**

- 7 pm Friday, March 25
  - Players begin checking in at the Team Toledo Ice House in Toledo, OH. Liability waivers are signed and practice jerseys handed out.
- 8 pm-10 pm Friday, March 25
  Players take the ice for a quick warm up session followed by a scrimmage amongst camp players and returning UT Hockey players.
- 9 am-11 am Saturday, March 26
   Players participate in a skills skate featuring drills our team uses on a regular basis.
   Meant to give players a feel for the tempo of a college practice.
- 12:00 pm-1:00 pm Saturday, March 26
   Players and their families are invited to lunch and a Q&A session with UT coaches and players at the UT Rec Center
- 1:00 pm-2:00 pm Saturday, March 26
   Players and their families take a campus tour set up just for camp attendees
- 4:00 pm-6:00 pm Saturday, March 26
   Players take part in the second game of the weekend and the final event for the camp.
