Player Transfer Requests must be reviewed and a decision rendered by Minor Hockey Associations and Regions within 5 days of receipt of the request.

- Fee structure

The fees remain unchanged for the 2008 2009 2009-2010 season and are listed on our website and registration package. Minor hockey players fee is \$36.00 and 8 and under \$34.00.

- Hockey Canada Registry (HCR) Database

- Hockey Canada is no longer circulating the "Safety for All" booklets and Insurance Information. This information is now available on the Hockey Manitoba website in both the Insurance and Hockey Forms section. Please note that it is extremely important to ensure all members are aware of this information.

- 2. Coach Certification
  - December 1<sup>st</sup> deadline
  - Respect in Sport December 1 deadline. (RIS/SO)
  - There will now be a 1-hour on-ice component added to the Initiation coach certification clinic.
