- Region needs to develop a standard approach to asking for sponsorship. Hopefully a group of Team managers and some Executive members can com up with something.

Head coaches may be required to take the higher level clinics to coach. Director Coulter proposes that the region offer grants to take the <u>High Performance Clinics</u> -

- require that they are head/assistant coaches of a regional team and payment be dependant on successful completion.

The Executive will develop a policy to issue grants for persons successfully completing the High Performance Clinics.
