- Thanks to all of the individuals who were involved with the development programs. We had 1 Future Stars team (Major Pee Wee's), 1 directors Cup and the regional send a number of individuals to the U16 Male POE and the U18 Female POE event which was part of the Manitoba games.
- All four regional teams had, what I would call, successful seasons. The primary goad of all programs is to
  give the players in our region a chance to compete at the highest level in the province. Not only are they doing
  that, but in many cases are having terrific success. The regional will once again conduct online surveys of the
  players and parents for all.
- Regional Website. Currently the regional website is hosted on the old Hockey Manitoba website. It works but I was wondering about making a change to hometeamsonline. ### Rural AAA Bantam League

Attended meeting in Portage during AAA Provincials. Appetite to form a rural league with approximately a 32-36 game schedule with a full playoff format. Champion to compete again city Champion for the right to go to Westerns. Tournament play will continue. Showcases will continue for chance to play the city teams. Rationale for this league:

Wpg fees very expensive

Need a more flexible schedule

Playoff format better way to declare a champion that Prov weekend.

Inclusion of Norman (single Roster for 2014/15). Winnipeg will not travel to Norman.

Long term goal to form a Provincial league similar to Midget.

## Midget 15/16

There may be rural entries in the Winnipeg city Midget AAA league. Regions are considering hosting their own teams, regions will not be required to participate. Some regions may combine. Another thought is that a number of centres be assigned teams and players would play for the closest centre. Rationale for this:

Chance for graduating Bantams to stay in AAA programs

Better chance to be able to complete for the regional AAA team on an AP basis

A way to continue to brand regional programs before potentially losing players to High School

hockey - which will ultimately strengthen AAA midget in all regions.
