POOL PLAY: The team listed first will be the home team. The work teams consist of five people: 2 linespeople, a

The five team pools will play two sets to 25 points (21 points each, start at 4) with a 27 cap. The six

team pool will play two sets to 15 points with a 17 cap.

We will have warm-up volleyballs available for you on each court. Warming up with volleyballs must be confined to the gymnasiums. Please do not allow your teams to use volleyballs in the lobbies, hallways, or cafeteria. Warm-ups prior to the teams' first matches will be 8 minutes, split 4-4. After

that, warm-up times will be limited to 6 minutes, split 3-3.






