In the Classroom \_As a representative of the volleyball team, I know that I am expected to be a role model in the classroom. I will work hard to maintain good attendance, be on time for class and earn strong grades in all of my classes. \_I will notify my teachers in advance if I will miss class for a volleyball-related activity. \_I will ask for help (from coach, teacher, student tutor, parent, or counselor) if I need assistance in a subject. \_\_I will follow all school rules and will treat all school officials, teachers and classmates with respect. In Practice \_I will attend practices when scheduled and will actively help set up the equipment and begin the warmup activities prior to practice. I will make good use of practice time and work to achieve good repetitions during drills and competition. I will attend all practices and team events, recognizing that the only excused absences include family emergencies, religious services and illnesses. I am expected to travel with the team unless I have unusual circumstances that I have had cleared through my coach in advance. \_\_\_\_I will notify my coach in advance if I am unable to attend a practice due to illness. \_I will listen attentively for information given by coaches in practice and be responsible to communicate necessary information (travel arrangements, etc back to my parent(s). In the Team \_I will encourage and support my teammates and refrain from negative behavior that is unproductive to the team's goals. I recognize that volleyball is a team sport and that sometimes means placing the needs of the team above my own desires. In trying out for the volleyball team, I agree to try my best to excel at whatever role (team, position, leadership) that is needed of me during a given time. I also understand that roles may change several times throughout the year. \_I will notify one of the coaches or senior leaders if there is an individual or team concern that needs to be addressed. \_I will treat all HHS equipment and uniforms with respect. I will turn in all parts of the uniform at the end of the season. \_I will complete all my team's fundraising, line judging, and ball retrieving requirements. \_I will cheer and support other teams in the HHS volleyball program. I recognize the importance of good sportsmanship and will treat my coaches, teammates, opponents and officials with respect at all times. I recognize that playing time is determined by an athlete's ability, effort, role, attitude, unselfishness, aggressive play and positive effect on the team. \*\*THIS IS ALSO DETERMINED BY THE COACH. \_I acknowledge that being part of the team is a privilege, not a right, and I will treat it as such. Out of School I will prepare myself physically for practice and competition by striving to eat a nutritious diet, getting enough rest and staying hydrated. (I will work to drink water prior to practice and bring a water bottle to practice each day.)
