PRESIDENT REPORT –Sheila Rice

TREASURER REPORT – Fiona Kimber

- Typical monthly operating expenses are on going at the cost of \$4000-\$5000 including paint, field maintenance, and bank fees.
- In addition to typical monthly operating expenses, the general booster board approved a \$1400 ultrasound machine, a \$4000 training table, and \$3000 in renewal of our subscription for Gametime for our music subscription.
- The General Booster Board will once again offer mini grants. The new criteria will be outlined soon, and the mini grant will offer teams the ability to make a purchase for up to \$1000 to support tangible items and durable goods used by the teams.

ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT REPORT- Mike Harrison

- The trainer has resigned from her position as shared via the letter sent by the Athletic Department via Constant Contact.
 - The position is posted and in the interim the athletic department has arranged for a freelance trainer to cover those athletic contests that require a trainer by state law.
- All teams must use Team Snap. If your team is not utilizing Team Snap and you need assistance with setting it up, please reach out to Liz Owen. Coaches are not supposed to text with their athletes and should use Team Snap to communicate with their athletes.
- Mike informed the group that he has put the Baker's Sporting Goods contract up for review. He will send an RFP to both Baker's Sporting Goods and BSN in Dallas for the uniform and merchandising business.

NEW BUSINESS/DISCUSSION ITEMS

- The issue of storage of uniforms and equipment was brought up to the group. The storage system for team uniforms and equipment varied by team with some teams paying for off campus storage.
 - The board committed to discussing this issue with the athletic department and getting back to the group with a consolidated storage plan.

Liaisons from all sports in attendance provided updates on their respective activities.
