

# PV Sharks Booster Club Meeting

Monday Oct. 6, 2014

The meeting was held at Ponte Vedra High School and called to order by President Dan Reiman at 7pm. Approx. 15 people were in attendance.

## **President's Report-** *Dan Reiman*

Dan reported that the unveiling of the scoreboard on Sept 26<sup>th</sup> at the football game was very well received by the sponsors. We had a pregame tailgate party and brought the sponsors on the field. Next year, we need to pick a more attended game. We need to get the pictures in Shark Bytes and the local paper.

Field Update- We have received two quotes to remedy the drainage problems on the field. We are also in the process of getting quotes to revamp the whole field. This will require a capital campaign as the total is probably in excess of 100K. A turf field is not on the table at this point. Need to learn how much the county will contribute. The track also has issues. It does not have lights and is two lanes short which does not allow us to have home meets. Need to understand why track is not around the football field. A field committee is being assembled to drive this project. We need a professional video to help with capital campaign.
