- ❖ Lunch Break @ 11:45 AM-1:00 PM
- Coaches/Referees game during lunch if time permits.

Volunteering

- ❖ Each team will be required to volunteer 8 linesperson during their scheduled breaks.
- During your respective games, a member from each team is required to volunteer as a scorekeeper.
- It is responsibility of each team's scorekeeper to ensure starting lineup for each set is captured.
- **❖** A no-show will result in a set loss with 25-0 in the next game the team is scheduled to play.
- ❖ For pre quarters, teams will be required to provide 1 linesperson and 1 scorekeeper.

Please note: Players/coaches volunteering will not miss any part of their games.



Rules & Regulations

Rule Book Page 5

The same rotation position must be maintained throughout the set that has been selected. If ref notices out of rotation

- 1st time team loses 1 point and serve, if serve side and opposing team gets a point
- 2nd time team loses 2 points and serve, if serve side and opposing team gets a point
- **❖** 3rd time team loses a set with 25-0

This enforcement is for the duration of the tournament.



Rules & Regulations

Time outs

- There are 2 1 minute times in each set
 - > At :45 secs, ref will give warning whistle
 - > At 1:00 min sharp, the ref will whistle again

Set Change

- Team has 2 minutes to start
 - ➤ At 1:45 secs, ref will give warning whistle
 - > At 2:00 min sharp, the ref will whistle again

Handshakes between sets are unnecessary and will be counted as part of the 2 mins set change time. Please wait till end of game to shake hands.

Housekeeping

Cleanliness of the facility is a responsibility of all participants.

- ❖ Teams will be responsible for cleaning the courts that they play on after the 10:30 AM game (prior to lunch).
