As a Farragut High School Lacrosse parent, I/We agree to the following code of conduct:

1. Assist in player's timely arrival to practice, games and team events.
2. Assist in the development of player's individual decision-making abilities by not offering instructions from the sidelines during practices or games.
3. Entrust lacrosse decisions to the coaches.
4. Pay all fees for services in the specified time frame unless a separate payment plan has been agreed upon.

6. Volunteer in some capacity as required by the club.
