

Lacrosse Player Agreement

I, _____ agree to adhere to the following rules during the 2022 Walled Lake Western Lacrosse season:

1. I will be on time to all practices, games, and team events. On time is defined as:

- being dressed, at the field/school/gym, and ready to begin 10 minutes before practice/conditioning/warmup start time

* If the coach requests a different time, that supersedes the above.

* If a player is unable to be on time, he will notify a coach prior to the above

2. All forms of drugs, nicotine/tobacco, and alcohol are prohibited. Drug use includes, but is not limited to, all forms of vaping, juul, etc. Any use of drugs/alcohol that results in disciplinary action by the school or is brought to the attention of the coaches can result in disciplinary action being taken by the coaches/team.

3. Any inappropriate representation of yourself or WLW lacrosse that is seen on social media can result in disciplinary action by the coaches/team.

4. Any negative attitude demonstrated by vulgarity, "talking back", inattentiveness, "sassiness", disengagement, bullying, fighting, or other disrespect directed towards coaches, referees, other players, or students can result in disciplinary action by the coaches/team.

5. Players may not bring their own speakers for playing music at practices or games. All pregame music will be selected by the coaching staff or designated parent and played over the stadium speakers. Players may request songs to be review by the coaches to determine if they are appropriate.

6. Any actions that detract from the image of the team, i.e., social media posts, hand gestures (including "gang signs") or being disrespectful to the other team, their coaches or their fans can result in disciplinary action.

7. Players will maintain a grade point average consistent with school requirements.

8. Any other action that results in disciplinary action by the school.

Disciplinary action for any of the above points will be determined by the coaching staff, and may match or exceed any pre-existing school action, up to immediate suspension or expulsion from the team.
