NASSAU-SUFFOLK DEKHOCKEY RULES AND REGULATIONS VOLUME 5 EFFECTIVE SPRING 1998

Dekhockey is a limited contact sport. Collisions are common and injuries can result. Players accept the hazards of participation and the dangers of injury incident thereto, including carelessness or negligence of fellow players.

REGISTRATION

- 1. Official age divisions shall be as follows: Cadet 13-15, Freshman 16-19, Senior 18 and over and Over The Hill 28 and over. Players must show proof of age in each division except Senior.
- 2. The first day of each season shall be the effective eligibility date for all leagues. Players must be the correct age for their division on the first day of the season. Players under age 18 may play in the Senior division with parental consent.
- 3. Nassau-Suffolk Dekhockey reserves the right to reject the registration of any team or group who in the opinion of management would negatively affect the leagues organization in any manner.
- 4. Registrations shall be held prior to each season. Only deposits of \$100 or greater will be accepted. Once the leagues appear full, conditional deposits will be accepted but may have to be returned. Teams are accepted on a first-come basis. Teams playing in any given season will have first opportunity to register for the next season.
- 5. At the captain's meeting prior to each season, captains are responsible for having paid \$425 toward their league fee and submitting their team roster fully executed. Rosters are considered closed at the captain's meeting. No further changes will be allowed unless authorized by management. Without meeting these demands, Nassau-Suffolk Dekhockey will not schedule any teams and will refund the initial deposit. ANY TEAM THAT BOUNCES A CHECK FOR CAPTAIN'S MEETING FEES WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE LEAGUE AND REPLACED BY A RESERVE TEAM!
- 6. Teams may receive a refund of their deposit during the registration period up until the captain's meeting. If after hearing the rules and policies explained during the captain's meeting, a team decides not to play, they may receive a refund at that time. Once a team gives in their conflicts and leave the captain's meeting no refund will be given and all monies paid up until that time will be used as a league rescheduling fee.
- 7. Players may not play on more than one team in the same division. Other limitations may be set by management at the captain's meeting prior to each season.
- 8. No team schedules will be released until full payment is made. If full payment is not made by the first game of the season, the team will lose by forfeit. Any team that forfeits the first two games of the season will be ejected from league play with no refund of any monies paid and the league will be rescheduled. A CHECK GIVEN AT THE FIRST GAME WHICH IS RETURNED NSF, WILL RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF ALL GAMES THE TEAM HAS PLAYED TO THE POINT THAT WE ARE NOTIFIED BY THE BANK AND RECEIVE CASH.
- 9. All players must have a photo identification card on file with management. Each season any new player added to a team's roster must obtain a photo ID card prior to playing a game at the facility. Any player participating without a photo identification card is illegal and will be suspended.
- 10. Each season all players must submit a hold-harmless registration form prior to playing a game. Any player participating without a signed form submitted is illegal, and if caught will be suspended in accordance with the league suspension policy. NOTE: Captain's are responsible to check with the manager on duty to see which players are eligible to play each game.
