

68. Players who repeatedly get suspended, could be given larger suspensions than the guidelines listed above.

PLAYOFFS

69. Playoff qualifications are decided by the final league standings in each division.

70. Tiebreakers for teams tied with the same amount of points at the end of the season will be decided by:

- 1- Wins during the regular season.
- 2- Head to head competition (RECORD ONLY).
- 3- Goals for during the season.
- 4- Goals against during the season.

71. Teams can play as many as 7 games in 10-12 days and no scheduling conflicts can be accepted.

72. The playoff schedule is set up around the game officials to insure that no official will ref a playoff game in a division in which they participated during the regular season.

MISCELLANEOUS

73. If a light on the rink goes out during a shift of games, it will be immediately be replaced the next day. The remaining games that must be played before it is replaced will use a four period format:

1st period 10 minutes

2nd period 10 minutes

3rd period 5 minutes (goaltenders remain in the same goal that they were defending in the 2nd period)

4th period 5 minutes (goaltenders switching ends to defend the net closest to their bench)

The team with the better record will get to call a coin toss to decide which end they would like to defend prior to the start of the game.

74. It is always the referees whistle that denotes a stoppage of play except to signify the end of a period which will then be referee discretion.
