68. Players who repeatedly get suspended, could be given larger suspensions than the guidelines listed above.

PLAYOFFS

- 69. Playoff qualifications are decided by the final league standings in each division.
- 70. Tiebreakers for teams tied with the same amount of points at the end of the season will be decided by:
 - 1- Wins during the regular season.
 - 2- Head to head competition (RECORD ONLY).
 - 3- Goals for during the season.
 - 4- Goals against during the season.
- 71. Teams can play as many as 7 games in 10-12 days and no scheduling conflicts can be accepted.
- 72. The playoff schedule is set up around the game officials to insure that no official will ref a playoff game in a division in which they participated during the regular season.

MISCELLANEOUS

73. If a light on the rink goes out during a shift of games, it will be immediately be replaced the next day. The remaining games that must be played before it is replaced will use a four period format:

1st period 10 minutes

2nd period 10 minutes

3rd period 5 minutes (goaltenders remain in the same goal that they were defending in the 2nd period)

4th period 5 minutes (goaltenders switching ends to defend the net closest to their bench)

The team with the better record will get to call a coin toss to decide which end they would like to defend prior to the start of the game.

74. It is always the referees whistle that denotes a stoppage of play except to signify the end of a period which will then be referee discretion.
