

### ERSC Policy regarding Club Tryouts (for u11 and older teams)

The ERSC / coach will be expected to hold a tryout that will be open to any youth player that is eligible age wise for that team .

ie: Consider a team that has a maximum roster of 16 and there are 20 age appropriate youth interested in those 16 spots, then a tryout or skills assessment would be announced and held.

ie: Consider a team from the previous year whose roster was full that had a player move out of the area, quit the team or was injured so that there was at least one empty spot on the roster for the next upcoming seasonal year, a tryout would be announced and held if there were other age appropriate players registered.

ie: Consider a team that goes from playing a 9v9 format to an 11v11 format, with the maximum roster going from 16 to 20 players, a tryout would be announced and held.

ie: Consider a team that has NO changes to their current roster, a tryout will be held.

Players wishing to participate in the tryout would be expected to be registered PRIOR to the tryout which means that all forms would be completed and turned in with the appropriate funds.

This policy is in effect June 2016

### ERSC Policy regarding Tryouts for any Club Tournament teams (any age)

The ERSC / coach will be expected to hold a tryout/ skills assessment or utilize the club skills assessment that is done prior to the draft for the Rec division of play within the ERSC.

Any player playing on a "tournament team" will need to be currently registered and participating on a club rec team within the ERSC to be considered for selection onto a tournament team.

### ERSC Policy regarding "switching" from one team in the club to another

The ERSC will not support a player who registered for one ERSC team deciding to "switch" to another ERSC team unless a Board Approved reason, i.e.: numbers , girl initially placed on a primarily boys team and then an opening is available on the girls team, etc
