1. Keith Avary is the 5th manager for the winter season.
He will be the 5th manager.
2. Draft day is 12/5. Agreed
3. Five teams with 14/15 roster sizes. How many have indicated that they want to leave early or are taking an extended vacation?
I thought we might have had 84 players and might want 6 teams, I miscounted and there will be 5.
4. With 5 teams we need to notify the league who has priority in the pool, bye team players, pool players or all of them have the same status. Pool
5. What bills do we have coming and how much; insurance, field rental, etc. You and I have talked about it and we are in good shape.
6. How are we doing on sponsors? We will probably get a new one, Hooters, and lose 2.
7. If too many players indicate that they do not want to play for a particular manager, do we have to rescind that rule and allow no one to opt out? The remedy could be trades that could be extended for up to 2 weeks into the season. Or, if a player has not notified the manager personally then they should be eligible to be drafted by that manager. We decided, after much

discussion, that we will NOT exclude anyone from being drafted by any manager.
