- 1. Do we want to up the minimum age to 60?
 - A discussion was had on the subject, but in the end, the current minimum age of 58 remains. There was also a brief discussion on changing the female age limit, but it too will remain unchanged at 40.
- 2. How is the runner rule working? The recent change will remain in effect. Those that require a runner can have anyone run (no longer just one of the last three outs), but can only run once per inning. If the designated runner is on base when they are up to bat, they will be called out and lose their place in the order. It was also decided to include Anthony Thomas in those "grandfathered" in for needing a runner always.
- 3. We should hold the commissioner election on 11/4. An election will be held for commissioner on Thursday, November 4, 2025. The term will begin 12/1/25. The cutoff date for those wanting to be considered is Friday, October 14, 2025.

Additional Items;

- A player luncheon is scheduled for September 25, 2025, immediately following the scheduled games. It will include a "taco bar" and beverages (beer & sodas). Due to the cost increase, the league will no longer add a tip to the final bill but will rely on individuals to tip the servers accordingly.
- A discussion was held concerning cost for each session. Playing in one session is \$35, if the player decides to play in the next session, it also is \$35. The \$75 annual fee covers all three sessions (winter, summer and fall).
