# Thank you for volunteering with the 2022 St. Pete/Clearwater Elite Invitational

Parking: For those volunteering at Fields 1-4, you will park at Fields 1-4. For those volunteering at Fields 8&9, you will park at Fields 5-7. Transportation to Fields 8&9 can be achieved by golf cart or by foot. The Jolley Trolley will circulate from Joe DiMaggio to Fields 1-4 and Fields 8&9, there is no scheduled stop at 5-7.

Check-in/Check-out: For those volunteering at Fields 1-4, you will check in and out at the volunteer tent in the parking lot. For those volunteering at Fields 8&9, you will check in and out at Fields 5-7 at the volunteer tent.

\*\*\*Please schedule time for your transportation to and from positions and check-in/check-out as well as for parking. Punctuality reporting to your position is imperative to ensure smooth operation of the event. This is a sold-out event so we will need all hands on deck and on time.

Dress: Plan according to the weather. Please wear your 3-Score shirt (and hat if you like/need) to help make yourself identifiable and as a possible conversation starter. Our preference of pant is a khaki short or pant (beige, blue, black, grey...). Jeans without holes or an Elite Invitational Volunteer shirt may be worn.

**Snacks:** Snacks will be available before and after your shift as well as during breaks at your assigned complex. Each volunteer will be supplied with a reusable water bottle which can be filled at the filling station located on the main building at each complex.

## **Descriptions** of the various volunteer positions:

<u>Trolley Stop Greeter</u> – Positioned at the trolly stop at each complex of games; greet guests as they

arrive to the complex on the trolly; direct them to the main gate entry; assist with any questions as necessary; maintain an orderly flow on/off the trollies

<u>Ticket Scanner</u> — Positioned at the main gate at each complex of games; greet guests; request to

see digital/paper ticket, confirm correct day/complex on ticket; scan using device provided (green good to go/red has either already been scanned or there

is a problem); once confirmed, invite guest in and direct them to get their wristband

# Wrist banders -

Positioned at the main gate at each complex of games; greet guests; request preference of right/left wrist, apply/fit wristband leaving enough space for comfort but not removal; invite guests into the complex (wristbands must be worn by the guest for entry/re-entry to a complex). Direct those with reserved seating tickets to the team wristband location for an additional wristband.

# Team Wrist Banders –

Positioned at the team wristband table within the complex. Ask to see their digital ticket to confirm which team the have reserved seats for. Check team list for seat assignment, mark that the seat has been claimed. Apply/fit team appropriate wristband on preferred wrist leaving enough space for comfort but not removal.

<u>Greeter/Information</u> — Positioned appropriately in each of the main walking corridors of each complex; greet guests; assist with finding fields and access to seats

> Field 1-4 - One person is positioned just beyond the entrance gate and one person is positioned inside the main complex floating along the main corridor; answering questions and greeting spectators as they arrive; keep an eye on the bullpen and practice areas, please do not let spectators into the team areas; assist with teams' entry and exit of the fields/complex as needed

Fields 8&9 - Once person positioned just inside of the main part of the complex and one person positioned just beyond the main building between the two game fields; both are floating through those areas of the complex answering questions and greeting spectators; keep an eye on the batting cage areas, please do not let spectators into the team areas; assist with teams' entry and exit of the fields/complex as needed

Field 1 and 3 Outfield Greeter/Usher - Positions are near the first set of bleachers and near the center of the area; direct to open seating; there is a VIP area located in right field on Field. 3 and left field on Field 1 for those with appropriate tickets/bands; please also monitor the fence lines and barricades around any camera structures, direct guests to seats

Reserved Seating Ushers - One person positioned at each end of the seating behind home plate to manage the in and out of the area; this seating area is for ADA seating (limited number available on a first come first served basis, media with credentials, coaches with credentials or spectators with the proper team wristband; any other individual with out all access credentials will not be permitted into this area; bleachers will have numbered seating

Scoreboard Operators - Positioned behind the backstop at the table; operate the scoreboard on assigned field for assigned game; please ensure understanding of function of each scoreboard prior to the game.

<u>Team/Staff Gate Monitor</u> — Positioned at back gate at Field 1-4 and pedestrian gate near left field on Field 9; greet teams and staff who arrive to this area; this entry is for teams and

staff only; if any spectator arrives to this area, please direct them to the main

gate entry; appropriate credentials should be displayed for entry

Golf Cart Driver - Based out of fields 5-7; assigned to transport umpires for a specific field of play;

transport game umpires to and from assigned field; need to be at umpire compound at least 30 minutes prior to game time and then at the game field by

the 5th inning; communicate with the event Umpire in Charge

<u>Lead Volunteer</u> – Based at assigned complex; ensure all are in appropriate position; answer any

questions; communicate with city site lead; relieve any volunteers who may

need to step away from post as needed
