# South repeats as state Division I softball champion

The South High softball team topped Chugiak 10-2 on Saturday to take the Alaska Division I Tournament championship at South Davis Park in Fairbanks.

South scored three in the first inning, five in the second inning and tacked on two in the third. That was all the Wolverines needed to earn back-to-back state titles. Chugiak scored both of its runs in the first inning.

The 2021 title game saw a similar score and an identical outcome. South beat Chugiak 8-2 in that one.
